Minutes of the November 28, 2016 meeting

The minutes of the October meeting were approved. There were no changes to the Treasurer's Report.

Montgomery County has added \$8M to the \$40M budget for road resurfacing next year. \$1.6M to \$2M has been allocated locally, including for work in Foxhall.

Representatives from the WSSC and KCI, the WSSC contractor, spoke about plans to replace the 16" water main along Georgia Avenue from Connecticut Avenue to Denley Road, and some smaller service lines along some of the side streets. Brandon Stuart is the WSSC Customer Advocate and Ling Li is the KCI project manager (301-206-8745). The project numbers are BT4802A08 and BR48025A08. Work on both projects will occur at the same time. Currently, they plan to start at the south end of the project area and work north. Much of the main in Glenmont has been replaced already in conjunction with Metro construction.

The 16" water main is part of the WSSC's aging infrastructure. It has reached its service life. The lines to be replaced were installed between the 1940's and the 1990's. This will result in a more robust infrastructure. New mains will usually be relocated to the roadway. BT4802A08 will replace the 16" transmission main along 2.1 miles of Georgia Avenue, and BR4802A08 will replace 8" service lines along .9 miles of side streets. Construction will be by the open cut method. Temporary service will be provided from local hydrants. Other utilities will not be affected. WSSC will restore the affected areas after a phase is completed.

Some house connections will be replaced to the property line. If a meter is underground, line will be replaced to the meter, and the meter raised to ground level.

Work will occur between 9am and 3pm, Monday thru Friday. No Parking signs will be posted on streets with construction activity. Roads will be accessible with temporary closures. Access to homes and businesses will be maintained. Tree pruning/removal will occur only as required; if trees are removed, they will be replaced in a different location.

Water shut-offs will not exceed 8 hours, if over 8 hours WSSC will deliver bottled water. Shut downs will be from valve to valve, valves are places every few hundred feet. Door tags will be placed on each door in the area to be shut down.
