The Agenda was approved. The Minutes of the November meeting were approved. Income statement @ 11/30/2015 – balance \$878.00. The only expense for the year was website renewal of \$25.00. Membership for 2015 included 7 associations, 2 businesses and 8 individuals.

The MetroCentre public hearing was held December 10th, Phase II was approved. MetroCentre redevelopment of Privacy World will be a town-center type of development. Site plans for Phase II shows the park area (stream valley buffer) and exercise trails.

A list of questions submitted by members has been sent to SHA to prepare for their presentation at the January meeting. Questions include traffic, construction schedule, and light timing. Firehouse access and signaling – regular or flashing? Effects on Layhill Road traffic.

Wheaton Library deconstruction will begin at the end of March, 2016.

Fencing is up at Plaza del Mercado for the demolition/Aldi and LA Fitness construction.

There is new pavement at the Glenmont Shopping Center between the Arcade and the bank.

A Post Office Box will be opened to provide a mailing address for 2016 membership.

Discussion of use of funds was delayed.

Construction of the bridge to connect Tivoli Lake Boulevard from Tivoli to Poplar Run has been completed, but it still needs pavement.
