

**Minutes of the June 25, 2018 meeting**

The Minutes were approved.

The Treasurers Report was approved. Budgeted membership revenue of \$410 has been received, also a \$10 contribution. Expenses are on target so far. A donation was made to the Kennedy High School After-Prom program. Expense for room rental for candidate forum of \$53.75 was approved and will be paid. Remaining budgeted expenses are for website and Montgomery County Civic Association dues.

The Glenmont Exchange hosted a Candidate Forum at Kennedy High School instead of the May meeting.

Randolph Road and Georgia Avenue Interchange – latest reports are that it will be substantially complete by August; still needs signage and pavement topcoat. Landscaping will follow later.

Discussion on what should we focus on in the future. Ideas included: Glenmont redevelopment around metro; MetroCentre development progress; Glenmont Shopping Center; Active Montgomery (Recreation, Parks and Community use of Public Facilities); What to do with the empty lot next to the new Fire Station (State Highway Administration to transfer grassy fields to the county); The old Vitro building at the corner of Aspen Hill Road and Connecticut Avenue – Lindsay Ford plans to build on the old slab.
