The Treasurer's Report showed Net Income of \$226.00 for the year, Cash on hand of \$1,084.00. Expenditures are expected for the Website and for Montgomery County Civic Federation dues. Dues have been received from 9 individuals, 6 associations and 2 businesses.

Election of officers: No other nominations were received, all officers will continue in office.

Discussion of abandoned house West of Georgia Avenue near Weller Road. Residents have had difficulty getting house condemned and demolished. House has been in and out of foreclosure.

Route 28/Route 198 Improvements: Plan expected to be finished in 2017, property acquisition and construction to begin in 2019. Plan consists of 5 segments, between Georgia Avenue and Burtonsville. A display of the plans is available in the Burtonsville Library. A potential downside to the road improvements is that more truck traffic will use the roads to bypass the ICC.

Georgia Avenue to Layhill Road: Will add congestion near new development on 28, Leisure World entrance, and access to local parks. Drury lane will need improved access to 28 and sidewalks.

Layhill Road to New Hampshire Avenue: No changes.

New Hampshire Avenue to West side of Burtonsville: Improve, not widen road, add two or three traffic circles.

Burtonsville: No widening planned for Burtonsville.
